A RESOLUTION CALLING ON THE RESIGNATION OF CLARKSVILLE CITY COUNCILMEMBER TRAVIS HOLLEMAN

WHEREAS, members of the the Clarksville Community just celebrated PRIDE month on Saturday, June 29, 2024; and

WHEREAS, sexual and gender minorities and their families are valued and respected members of the Clarksville Community; and

WHEREAS, Councilman Travis Holleman recently grossly mischaracterized the political and religious motivations of sexual and gender minorities in his ward and in this city; and

WHEREAS, Councilman Holleman accused these minorities of unspeakably heinous offenses; and

WHEREAS, Councilman Holleman misrepresented the job title of a city employee and maligned their character; and

WHEREAS, it is the duty of Clarksville City Council to faithfully represent the true interests of its constituents; and

WHEREAS, such representation must exclude misinformation and mischaracterization intended to harm the reputation, integrity, and advancement of lesbian, gay, bisexual, transgender, queer, and other sexual minorities; and

WHEREAS, it is the responsibility of our government to promote the welfare and progress of all people of the City of Clarksville, TN.
